WHEREAS, Mr. Rombocos presented the America the Beautiful Memorial to the City of Colorado Springs during a dedication ceremony held at America the Beautiful Park on August 1, 2006; and

WHEREAS, The City of Colorado Springs extends its heartfelt appreciation for Costas Rombocos' contributions to this community and for his willingness to continuously strive to inspire the citizens of Colorado Springs to appreciate the wonderful city and country in which they live, work and play.
